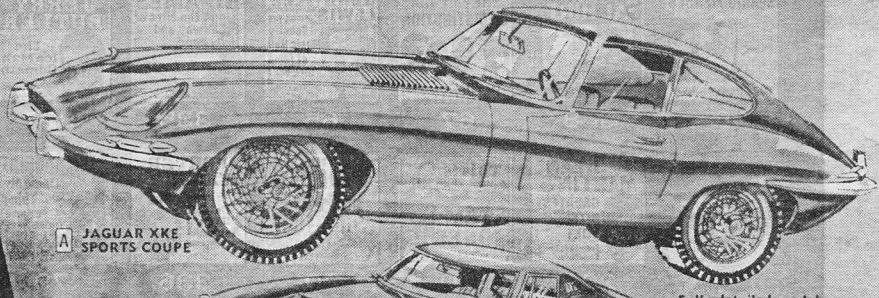

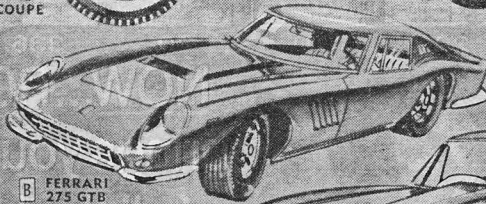

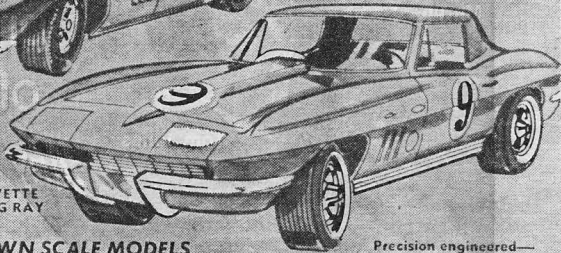

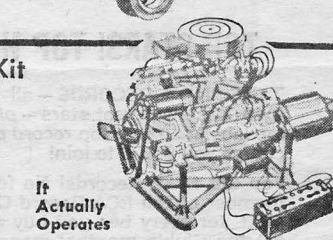

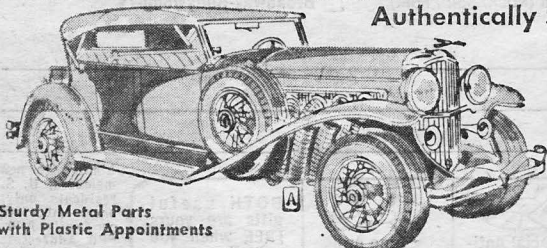


VISIBLE MODEL V8 Engine Kit
